

Policy on How to Become a member of Bridport Cohousing
December 2016 (amended Dec 2017)

The aim of this Policy: is to have a clearly-described and transparent process by which people become Members of Bridport Cohousing (BC).

Step one

People who are interested in Bridport Cohousing contact the group initially by:-

- Website: via the enquiry form on the contact page www.bridportcohousing.org.uk or
- Email: info@bridportcohousing.org.uk or
- Phone: 07907 993 587, giving their email address.

Bridport Cohousing: the membership team responds by email with a range of documents giving initial information about the project, and how to become a Member.

Step two

The enquirer: tells us they are very interested and would like more information.

Bridport Cohousing: responds with a second mailing with -

- further information about the project
- a copy of the Personal Information Form, which is our membership application form; (see below for a sample copy for information only).

The enquirer: attends at least four BC open meeting or events over a period of time, in order to meet other Members of the group and to demonstrate commitment and willingness to spend time with other members on the project.

Step three

The enquirer: sends a completed Personal Information Form (PIF)

Bridport Cohousing: sends the PIF out to all current members by email for comment, to establish that sufficient Members have met the potential new Member, to ascertain their aptitude for the cohousing lifestyle. In the event of insufficient members having met the enquirer BC will arrange an event where several Members can spend time with the enquirer.

When there are no concerns from Members an informal meeting is arranged between two Members and the potential new Member, to confirm that the potential new Member is clear about the benefits and obligations of Membership of the project before signing a written commitment to this effect.

NB Possible limits to the number of Members

During the early phases of the project, there will be no limit set on the number of potential residents accepted for membership, providing they meet the Membership criteria. Members are warned that acceptance into Membership of BC does not guarantee being allocated a home.

The reason for keeping membership unrestricted at this stage is to give as many people as possible the opportunity to explore actively whether the project will suit them or not. Experience within BC and other projects has shown that there is a significant natural turnover of people during these earlier stages.

During later phases Bridport Cohousing will only take deposits equal to the number of homes that will be available, and invite other members to join a waiting list.
